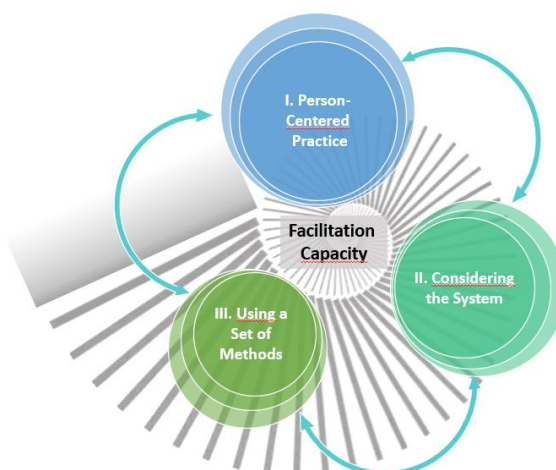

Facilitation is a participative method that helps a group to exchange ideas effectively and to co-construct, while making the most of everyone's knowledge.

Today, more than ever, managers and administrators need participative methods to innovate, motivate, give meaning, communicate better and make the right decisions.

Properly applied, these approaches engage teams or stakeholders in a motivating and creative dynamic, conducive to change. This is based on three essential pillars: adopting the right posture, understanding the systemic context of each meeting, workshop or project, and mastering the methods adapted to each situation. This is the essence of the triple approach to facilitation:



Objectives

We will cover the definition of facilitation, the facilitator's relationship with the client and the group, contextual analysis prior to a project or workshop, adopting a person-centered posture, facilitator communication (non-violent communication), as well as the design and practical facilitation of workshops and meetings. Trainees will also learn how to create their own toolbox. The aim of this training is for each participant to fully integrate these skills.
